This week we learned about rainbows and each of the colors in the




rainbow. We learned why we see rainbows when it rains, related the color wheel in art to the rainbow, and discussed/graphed what color was our favorite in the rainbow.

Students rolled a dice and counted the next three numbers from the number rolled (rolled 3 on the dice; students would write 4, 5, 6).




Once the students got the hang of it, we added two dice. And we also worked
