an unknown word during Guided Reading. These strategies include: getting mouth ready, looking for picture clues, and

rereading the sentence. When reading with your child at home, please incorporate these strategies as well.

Next week our letter focus will be on the letter Uu. Please practice the sound of Uu, including both long and short vowel sounds. Look for objects around your house that beginning with letter Uu and ask your child if it makes a long or short vowel sound.





Our theme of the week will include holidays. We will learn about how people throughout the world celebrate holidays. In Math we will continue to work with fact families, create objects using pattern blocks, and solve story problems in our math journals.
